### **HISTORY**


The history of the University is on par with the development of national legal schools in Uzbekistan and the names of such legal scholars as Khadicha Suleimanova, Khodjiakbar Rakhmonkulov, Boris Blinder, Georgy Sarkisyants, Shavkat Urazaev, Malik Khakimov, Shoakbar Shorakhmetov, Gafur Abdumajidov, Ikram Zakirov and many others.

The main stages of the formation of the university:

- 1932 founded as an educational institution for the training of legal personnel;
- 1937 reorginized as Tashkent Law Institute;
- 1955 transformed into the Faculty of Law of the Central Asian State University (CASU), and then the Tashkent State University (TashSU).
- 1991 Tashkent State Institute of Law was established;
- 2013 transformed into Tashkent State University of Law.



# **TSUL IN NUMBERS**



In total, 1167 students graduated from TSUL in the 2021/2022 academic year. Currently, 672 graduates, or 60.4% of all graduates, are employed.








Depending on the needs of the population, a legal clinic can specialize in certain areas of legal regulation or provide advice to citizens on general issues of law.

The IRC fund (information resource center) includes more than 300,000 copies of national and foreign publications. The capacity of the IRC is 248 seats. #### **COMPETITIONS**

**Philip C. Jessup International Law Moot Court Competition –** the world's largest moot court competition, with over 700 law schools from 100 countries and jurisdictions participating. The competition is a simulation of a fictitious dispute between countries in the International Court of Justice, the judicial body of the United Nations.

**Willem C. Vis Moot –** Competition on International Commercial Arbitration. The purpose of the competition is to promote the study of international commercial law and arbitration to resolve international business disputes by applying it to a specific client problem.

**The John H. Jackson Moot Court Competition –** is an annual international moot court competition on WTO law organized by the European Law Students Association.





# TSUL MUN TSUL COURT

#### **TSUL MUN (MODEL UNITED NATIONS)**

The model of the United Nations is a synthesis of scientific conference and roleplay, during which students and high school students in several official languages of the UN reproduce the work of the bodies of this Organization, acquire diplomatic, leadership, oratory and language skills and the ability to come to a compromise.

#### **TSUL COURT**

Competition of demonstration trial in civil, criminal, administrative and economic cases.

In the competition, participants demonstrate theoretical knowledge of legal processes in practice.



### **STREET LAW**

The Street Law project is being implemented in secondary schools and legal technical schools of the republic with the methodological support of the Tashkent State Law University.

To date, about 1000 university students are participating in the project.

The project provides for trainings, meetings and conferences within the framework of the project, ensuring the participation of academic resources and experts necessary for the effective conduct of "Street Law" by the Tashkent State Law University and legal technical schools.

#### For the reference

In the 2020-2021 academic year, 555 students and student volunteers, 86 professors and teachers took part in the Republican project "Street Law". The project was implemented in 131 schools. In total, 8,090 schoolchildren took part in the lessons of the project.

#### Visa to Uzbekistan

Foreign citizens - students of TSUL are issued a visa type "A-1" - Study entry visa.

A visa is issued for up to 1 year to foreign citizens studying in educational institutions located on the territory of the Republic of Uzbekistan, issued at the request of educational institutions, ministries, departments and organizations of the Republic of Uzbekistan that have educational institutions in their jurisdiction.

# **DOUBLE DEGREE PROGRAMS**

Applicants who submitted documents to the bachelor's program of the Tashkent State University of Law (TSUL), but could not enter, have the right to take part in the competition for double-diploma bachelor's programs.

## **SCHOLARSHIPS AND GRANTS**



Chevening Scholarship is a UK Government grant for master's degree studies at universities in the UK. Scholarship conditions:

- be a citizen of Uzbekistan;
- return to Uzbekistan for at least two years after the expiration of the grant;
- obtain a bachelor's degree, which will allow you to enroll in a master's program at a British university by the time you apply;
- have at least two years (equivalent to 2,800 hours) of work experience;
- apply to study at three different universities in the UK and receive an invitation letter from one of these universities.

The scholarship covers tuition, flight, accommodation, daily expenses, etc.

Fulbright International Student Program - Scholarship US government for master's studies at US universities.



To participate in the program, the applicant must:

- be a citizen of Uzbekistan and reside in the country throughout the application and selection process;
- get a bachelor's degree;
- have at least two years of work experience.

The grant includes:

- tuition fees at a US university;
- monthly stipend;
- support in obtaining a J-1 visa;
- limited health insurance;
- payment of transport costs.
